

Mechanic

This position will assemble, maintain, prepare parts and equipment for delivery to customers.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Perform assembly of mechanical parts and equipment for powertrains and related components.
- Ensure functionality and reliability of machines, parts and mechanical systems for various types of equipment.
- Performs maintenance, inspections and service on parts and equipment to include stripping, painting, etc.
- Thoroughly cleans machines and machine parts, removing parts and reinstalling.
- Oils and lubricates moving parts on machines to ensure effective performance.
- Reports damaged, worn, or broken parts.
- Cleans, organizes, inventories, stocks, and otherwise maintains shop areas, parts, tools, and supplies.
- Provide general support for building maintenance.
- Other duties as assigned.

Qualifications and Requirements:

- High school diploma or equivalent preferred; vocational school or certificates in related field strongly preferred.
- At least two years of relevant work experience required.
- Ability to read, understand, and follow assembly instructions.
- Must have manual dexterity and great attention to detail.
- Must be able to work with various machines and tools.
- Ability to operate forklift and other standard warehouse equipment.
- Basic understanding of schematic drawings.
- Ensure a clean and safe working environment.
- Ability to organize, prioritize, and perform multiple tasks with minimal supervision.
